NEW RULES & REGULATIONS FOR MISSOURI

Starting September 1, 2011 Trichomoniasis (Trich) testing of bulls.

This bull testing program aims to find & eradicate trich, a sexually transmitted disease in cow herds. Under the new rules, any nonvirgin bulls or bulls 24 months of age or older, not going to slaughter, must have a negative trich test within 30 days prior to change of ownership or possession. A similar law already exists for breeding bulls coming into the state.
